

Nasik (Gulshanabad) Mint – Silver, Rupee *et infra*

The coins have a distinctive mark of a pennant on the reverse



sikka mubārah bādshāh ghāzī shāh ‘ālam (= the auspicious coin of the victorious Emperor Shāh ‘Ālam).



(zārb gulshanābād) sanah [RY] julūs maimanat mānūs (= struck at Gūlshanābād in the [RY] year of tranquil prosperity).
