

Indo-Greek – Eucratides I (c170-145 BC) – Gold – Type 3

This extraordinary coin can be linked to the reign of Eucratides I by the use of the same monogram that appears on his very rare gold staters. Though this monogram was also used by the Indo-Greek kingdom, notably on tetradrachms of Apollodotus I, the latter is not known to have struck coins in gold. (Comment from Roma)

Indo-Greek – Eucratides I (c170-145 BC) – Copper – Type 11

This bronze Type, which Bopearachchi refers to as a posthumous issue, is of great rarity (last offered at CNG Mail Bid Sale 81, 2009, lot 686). The Kharoshti legend identifies the enthroned figure as the city goddess of Kapisa (kavisiye), which is believed to be located in the area of Alexandria in the Caucasus (Begram). The other elements of the lapel image coincide with the travelogue of Hiuen Tsang (602 - 664 AD), according to which there was a mountain called Pilusara (Pi-lo-sa-lo) southwest of Kapisa, whose patron deity was in the form of an elephant.
